#14 A Study Trip to Tokyo and Tsukuba

From November 6th to 10th, the students of the Science and Mathematics Course in Kyuyo High School went to Tokyo and Tsukuba. They visited some universities, laboratories and many facilities. They seemed to take a growing interest in studying science through this trip.
