SS Science and Mathematics Inquiry II Tokyo Study Trip (Nov 7 – 11, 2022)

150 second-year science and mathematics students participated in a five-day, four-night study trip in Tokyo. On the first day, they participated in the Disney Academy and learned about Disney's hospitality philosophy. On the morning of the third day, they visited Tokyo Metropolitan University, Chiba University, Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology, and Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology, where they were able to deepen their knowledge of university studies and science research through lectures and explanations. In the afternoon, they conducted independent training around Ueno Park, and were able to deepen their knowledge by visiting various facilities (National Museum of Nature and Science, Ueno Zoo, Tokyo National Museum, etc.). On the fourth day, each SSH group planned voluntary training covering the entire Tokyo metropolitan area, and visited universities, facilities, companies, etc. related to SSH research. Each team was able to touch on various interests, and it was a very meaningful time from the perspective of STEAM education. On the fifth day, we visited Miraikan, the National Museum of Emerging Science and Innovation, and were able to experience science in various fields.



SDGs Study Quest I Entrepreneur Program ① (Tue, Nov 8, 2022)

In collaboration with the Okinawa City Business Attraction Division, we implemented the first Entrepreneur Program as part of SDGs Study Quest I. We invited a lecturer from Ryukyu Mirai Co., Ltd. to give a lecture on startups.
