We held an orientation for teachers assigned to Kyuyo High School this new school year. It dealt with the significance of our school SSH activities and its various initiatives.



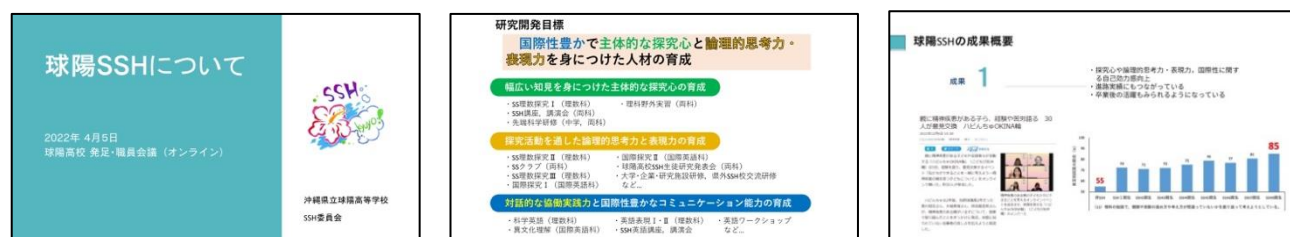
SSH Exploratory Research I・II・III. SDGs Study Quest I・II 1st Staff Meeting

We conducted an orientation online for SDGs Study Quest I for 2nd year students of the International English Department. The fact that students in each respective field must draw from their own interests, organize, translate and verbalize their ideas was explained. Moreover, points to note when doing exploratory research activities, and the overview of the year was discussed.
